AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to requiring alcohol and substance use screening for all incoming college students

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 6432-a 2 to read as follows:

§ 6432-a. Alcohol and substance use screening. 1. Each college shall 4 administer an alcohol and substance use screening or assessment to all incoming students.

- 2. The screening or assessment may be in person, online or written. This shall include the screening for illegal drugs and prescription medication for non-medical uses, including but not limited to heroin and other opioids.
- 3. Colleges may use evidence-based alcohol and substance use screening 11 instruments already approved by the office of alcoholism and substance abuse services. The commissioner, in collaboration with the commissioner 12 of health and the office of alcoholism and substance abuse services, 13 14 <u>shall develop guidance for colleges and provide resources and materials</u> 15 to assist in the development of a drug prevention program and alcohol 16 <u>and drug intake assessment.</u>
- 17 § 2. This act shall take effect the first of July next succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law. 18
