AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to the requirement that certain health clubs shall have at least one automated external defibrillator available upon the premises

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 627-a of the general business law, 2 as amended by chapter 31 of the laws of 2011, is amended to read as 3 follows:

- 1. Every health club as defined under paragraph b of subdivision one of section three thousand-d of the public health law whose membership is [five hundred] fifty persons or more shall have available on the premises in a manner that provides obvious and ready accessibility to staff, members and guests at least one automated external defibrillator and shall have in attendance, at all times during staffed business hours, at least one individual performing employment or individual acting as an authorized volunteer who holds a valid certification of completion of a course in the study of the operation of AEDs and a valid certification of the completion of a course in the training of cardiopulmonary resuscitation provided by a nationally recognized organization or associtation.
- 16 § 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 17 it shall have become a law.
