AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to collaborative agreements to purchase, acquire, possess and operate automated external defibrillators; and to repeal subdivision 2 of section 3000-b of such law, relating thereto

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Paragraph (ii) of subdivision 2 of section 3000-a of the 2 public health law, as amended by chapter 373 of the laws of 2016, is 3 amended to read as follows:
 - (ii) an emergency health care provider under a collaborative agreement pursuant to <u>the former subdivision two of</u> section three thousand-b of this article with respect to an automated external defibrillator, or
- 7 § 2. Paragraph (c) of subdivision 1 of section 3000-b of the public 8 health law, as added by chapter 552 of the laws of 1998, is amended to 9 read as follows:
- 10 (c) "Public access defibrillation provider" means a person, firm, 11 organization or other entity possessing or operating an automated 12 external defibrillator [pursuant to a collaborative agreement under this section].
- 14 § 3. Subdivision 2 of section 3000-b of the public health law is 15 REPEALED.
- 16 § 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
