AN ACT to amend the correction law, in relation to prohibiting county correction officers from dispensing medication using syringes or needles in jails to inmates

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 505 of the correction law is amended by adding a 2 new subdivision 5 to read as follows:

5. County correction officers in local correctional facilities shall
not dispense or administer medication using hypodermic syringes or hypodermic needles to inmates on the premises of a local correctional facility as defined in subdivision sixteen of section two of this chapter,
unless they are otherwise authorized to do so. This provision shall not
apply to dispensing of pill-based medication to inmates.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
