AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to eliminating a disincentive for whistleblowers

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 7 of section 740 of the labor law, as added by chapter 660 of the laws of 1984, is amended to read as follows:

7. Existing rights. Nothing in this section shall be deemed to diminish the rights, privileges, or remedies of any employee under any other law or regulation or under any collective bargaining agreement or employment contract[; except that the institution of an action in accordance with this section shall be deemed a waiver of the rights and remedies available under any other contract, collective bargaining greement, law, rule or regulation or under the common law].

10 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
