AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to voter notification of special elections

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 4-120 of the election law is amended by adding a new subdivision 4 to read as follows: <u>4. In addition to the requirements of subdivision one of this section,</u> <u>4 the board of elections shall, not later than ten nor more than fifteen</u> <u>5 days before a special election, mail, by first class mail, to each voter</u> <u>6 eligible to vote in an election district at such special election, a</u> <u>7 notice setting forth the day of the special election, the location of</u> <u>8 the polling place for such special election, and the public officers to</u> <u>9 be voted for at such special election. The board of elections shall also</u> <u>10 make such voter information available on their website.</u>

11 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
