AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to aggravated harassment in the first degree

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 4 of section 240.31 of the penal law, as 2 amended by chapter 74 of the laws of 2008, is amended to read as 3 follows:
- 4 4. Sets on fire a cross in public view <u>or displays a swastika, common-</u>
 5 <u>ly exhibited as the emblem of Nazi Germany, on a billboard, aerial</u>
 6 <u>display or by a similar method for uninvited public viewing</u>; or
- 7 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
