AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to state appropriations to the state university of New York and the city university of New York

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Clause (v) of subparagraph 4 of paragraph h of subdivision
2 2 of section 355 of the education law, as amended by section 1 of part
3 JJJ of chapter 59 of the laws of 2017, is amended to read as follows:

4 (v) Beginning in state fiscal year two thousand seventeen--two thou-
5 sand eighteen [~~and ending in state fiscal year two thousand twenty-two~~
6 ~~thousand twenty-one~~] and thereafter, the state shall appropriate and
7 make available general fund operating support[~~, including~~] and fringe
8 benefits, for the state university and the state university health
9 science centers in an amount not less than the [~~amount~~] amounts sepa-
10 ately appropriated and made available in the prior state fiscal year;
11 provided, further, the state shall appropriate and make available gener-
12 al fund operating support to cover all mandatory costs of the state
13 university and the state university health science centers, which shall
14 include, but not be limited to, collective bargaining costs including
15 salary increments, fringe benefits, and other non-personal service costs
16 such as utility costs, building rentals and other inflationary expenses
17 incurred by the state university and the state university health science
18 centers, and any increase in the tuition credit pursuant to section six
19 hundred eighty-nine-a of this title as tuition increases are enacted by
20 the board of trustees of the state university; provided, however, that
21 if the governor declares a fiscal emergency, and communicates such emer-
22 gency to the temporary president of the senate and speaker of the assem-
23 bly, state support for operating expenses at the state university and
24 city university may be reduced in a manner proportionate to one another,
25 and the aforementioned provisions shall not apply; provided further, the
26 state shall appropriate and make available general fund support to fully

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1 fund the tuition credit pursuant to subdivision two of section six
2 hundred sixty-nine-h of this title.

3 § 2. Subparagraph (v) of paragraph (a) of subdivision 7 of section
4 6206 of the education law, as amended by section 2 of part JJJ of chap-
5 ter 59 of the laws of 2017, is amended to read as follows:

6 (v) Beginning in state fiscal year two thousand seventeen--two thou-
7 sand eighteen and [~~ending in state fiscal year two thousand twenty-two~~
8 ~~thousand twenty-one~~] thereafter, the state shall appropriate and make
9 available general fund operating support[~~, including~~] and fringe bene-
10 fits, for the city university in an amount not less than the [~~amount~~]
11 amounts separately appropriated and made available in the prior state
12 fiscal year; provided, further, the state shall appropriate and make
13 available general fund operating support to cover all mandatory costs of
14 the city university, which shall include, but not be limited to, collec-
15 tive bargaining costs, including salary increments, fringe benefits, and
16 other non-personal service costs such as utility costs, building rentals
17 and other inflationary expenses incurred by the city university, and any
18 increase in the tuition credit pursuant to section six hundred eighty-
19 nine-a of this chapter as tuition increases are enacted by the board of
20 trustees of the city university; provided, however, that if the governor
21 declares a fiscal emergency, and communicates such emergency to the
22 temporary president of the senate and speaker of the assembly, state
23 support for operating expenses at the state university and city univer-
24 sity may be reduced in a manner proportionate to one another, and the
25 aforementioned provisions shall not apply; provided further, the state
26 shall appropriate and make available general fund support to fully fund
27 the tuition credit pursuant to subdivision two of section six hundred
28 sixty-nine-h of this chapter.

29 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately provided that:

30 (a) the amendments to subparagraph 4 of paragraph h of subdivision 2
31 of section 355 of the education law made by section one of this act
32 shall not affect the expiration and reversion of such subparagraph
33 pursuant to chapter 260 of the laws of 2011, as amended, and shall
34 expire therewith; and

35 (b) the amendments to paragraph (a) of subdivision 7 of section 6206
36 of the education law made by section two of this act shall not affect
37 the expiration and reversion of such paragraph pursuant to chapter 260
38 of the laws of 2011, as amended, and shall expire therewith.
