This act shall take effect [on the first of January next succeed-4 ing the date on which it shall have become a law] June 30, 2018; provided, however, that effective immediately, the addition, amendment 5 6 and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the implementation 7 of this act on its effective date [ie] are authorized to be made and 8 completed by the commissioner of health on or before such effective 9 date. 10 3. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that § 11 section one of this act shall take effect on the same date and in the same manner as a chapter of the laws of 2017, amending the public health 12 13 law, relating to maternal depression treatment, as proposed in legisla-
