AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to expanding the definition of "minority group member" for purposes of participation by minority group members and women with respect to state contracts

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subdivision 8 of section 310 of the executive law, as added by chapter 261 of the laws of 1988, is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (b) [Hispanic] Hispanic/Latino persons of Mexican, Puerto Rican, 5 Dominican, Cuban, Central or South American of either Indian or Hispanic 6 origin, regardless of race;
- 7 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that 8 the amendments to paragraph (b) of subdivision 8 of section 310 of the 9 executive law made by section one of this act shall not affect the expination of such section and shall be deemed expired therewith.
