- AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to suspending the registration of a vehicle which has been documented five times by a photo violation monitoring device for failure of an operator thereof to comply with traffic-control indications

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new
section 1118 to read as follows:
<u>§ 1118. Failure to comply with traffic control signal. The registra-</u>
tion of a vehicle which has been documented five times within a twelve
month period by a photo violation monitoring device for failure of an
operator thereof to comply with traffic-control indications shall be
suspended for a period of six months commencing five days after the
notice of liability for the fifth violation has been mailed; provided,
however, that this section shall not apply to a rental vehicle, as
defined in section one hundred thirty-seven-a of this chapter.

11 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
