AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to authorizing and directing the metropolitan transportation authority to implement a free fare program for emergency medical technicians and paramedics

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 1266 of the public authorities law is amended by
2 adding a new subdivision 14-a to read as follows:

3 14-a. Notwithstanding any other provisions of law or the terms of any
4 contract, the authority and any of its subsidiary corporations, shall
5 establish and implement a free fare program for transportation on New
6 York city transit authority systems, the Long Island Rail Road and the
7 Metro-North Commuter Railroad Company for emergency medical technicians
8 and paramedics employed by the city of New York. The free fare program
9 established and implemented pursuant to this subdivision shall be in
10 operation during all hours in which such authority provides railroad,
11 subway and/or omnibus services, and such program shall not be limited in
12 operation to off-peak hours or to any other hours designated by the
13 authority or its subsidiary corporations.

14 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
