AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to adding cannabimimetic agents to the schedule of controlled substances

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Schedule I of section 3306 of the public health law is amended by adding a new subdivision (i) to read as follows:
- (i) (1) Cannabimimetic agents. Unless specifically exempted or unless listed in another schedule, any material, compound, mixture, or preparation that is not approved by the federal food and drug administration (FDA) which contains any quantity of cannabimimetic agents, or which contains their salts, isomers, and salts of isomers whenever the existence of such salts, isomers, and salts of isomers is possible within the specific chemical designation.
- 10 (2) As used in this subdivision, the term "cannabimimetic agents"
  11 means any substance that is a cannabinoid receptor type 1 (CB1 receptor)
  12 agonist as demonstrated by binding studies and functional assays within
  13 any of the following structural classes:
- 14 (i) 2-(3-hydroxycyclohexyl)phenol with substitution at the 5-position 15 of the phenolic ring by alkyl or alkenyl, whether or not substituted on 16 the cyclohexyl ring to any extent.
- 17 (ii) 3-(1-naphthoyl)indole or 3-(1-naphthylmethane)indole by substi18 tution at the nitrogen atom of the indole ring, whether or not further
  19 substituted on the indole ring to any extent, whether or not substituted
  20 on the naphthoyl or naphthyl ring to any extent.
- 21 (iii) 3-(1-naphthoyl)pyrrole by substitution at the nitrogen atom of 22 the pyrrole ring, whether or not further substituted in the pyrrole ring 23 to any extent, whether or not substituted on the naphthoyl ring to any 24 extent.
- 25 <u>(iv) 1-(1-naphthylmethylene)indene by substitution of the 3-position</u> 26 <u>of the indene ring, whether or not further substituted in the indene</u>
