AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to certain tuition waivers for police officer students of the city university of New York and the state university of New York; and providing for the repeal of certain provisions upon the expiration thereof

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1	Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subdivision 7 of section 6206 of the
2	education law, as added by chapter 548 of the laws of 2004, is amended
3	to read as follows:
4	(c) Notwithstanding the provisions of any other general, special or
5	local law, rule or regulation, the board of trustees shall promulgate
б	regulations to permit members of the New York city police department
7	employed in the rank of police officer, who are enrolled in programs
8	leading to baccalaureate or higher degrees at a senior college of the
9	city university to attend [one course] two courses without tuition,
10	provided that such [course is] courses are related to their employment
11	as police officers and that such tuition-waived attendance does not deny
12	course attendance at a senior college of the city university by an indi-
13	vidual who is otherwise qualified under this section.
14	§ 2. Section 355 of the education law is amended by adding a new
15	subdivision 20 to read as follows:
16	20. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other general, special or
17	local law, rule or regulation, the state university trustees shall
18	promulgate regulations to permit members of the New York city police
19	department employed in the rank of police officer, who are enrolled in
20	programs leading to baccalaureate or higher degrees at a state-operated
21	institution in a state university, to attend two courses without
22	tuition, provided that such courses are related to their employment as
23	police officers and that such tuition-waived attendance does not deny
