AN ACT to amend the real property tax law, in relation to the real property tax exemption for persons with disabilities and limited incomes

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The closing paragraph of subdivision 2 of section 459-c of the real property tax law, as amended by chapter 265 of the laws of 2013, is amended to read as follows:

An award letter from the Social Security Administration or the Rail-5 road Retirement Board, or a certificate from the state commission for the blind, or an award letter from the United States Postal Service, or an award letter from the United States department of veterans affairs obtain an award letter from the Social Security Administration due to 10 insufficient work credits to qualify for SSDI, a denial or disapproval letter or notice of disapproved claim from the Social Security Adminis-12 tration together with a medical certification of the individual's qualifying disability prepared by a duly licensed physician and a medical 13 14 certification of the individual's qualifying disability prepared by the 15 workers' compensation board shall be deemed sufficient in lieu of an 16 award letter from the Social Security Administration. Such medical certification of the individual's qualifying disability as prepared by 17 18 the workers' compensation board pursuant to this subdivision shall take into account the results of such medical determination of the individ-19 20 <u>ual's qualifying disability as was prepared by a duly licensed physician</u> 21 pursuant to this subdivision.

22 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
