AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to exempting not-for-profit organizations from the requirements for labeling of collection bins

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 399-bbb of the general business
2 law, as amended by chapter 524 of the laws of 2015, is amended to read
3 as follows:

4 3. Any person, business, [~~not-for-profit-organization~~] or other entity
5 or entities, or an agent or agents, whether paid or not paid, of such
6 person, business, [~~not-for-profit-organization~~] or other entity, who
7 places a publicly accessible collection bin in a public place on private
8 property shall affix to the publicly accessible collection bin a label
9 that is designed to be incapable of being destroyed or removed and that
10 clearly and conspicuously displays in at least twenty-four point type
11 unless otherwise specified in this section and on the front of the
12 publicly accessible collection bin in a manner that is readily visible
13 to an individual placing property in the publicly accessible collection
14 bin the following:

15 (a) the name of the person, business, not-for-profit organization or
16 other entity which owns the publicly accessible collection bin and any
17 agent thereof; the legal address, telephone number, e-mail address and
18 website, if applicable, of such person, business, [~~not-for-profit-organ-~~
19 ~~ization~~] or other entity and any agent thereof where the owner of the
20 publicly accessible collection bin or its agent can be reached during
21 ordinary business hours; any permit or license required by local law of
22 such person, business, [~~not-for-profit-organization~~] or other entity and
23 any agent thereof; a statement that nothing shall be left outside of
24 such bin; and a statement that shall take the following form: For more
25 information, contact the department of law at (insert the current tele-
26 phone number established by the department of law for receiving
27 inquiries from consumers) or (insert the current address of the website

4 numbers and any permits or licenses required by local law of such owners
5 shall be included in the disclosure label. If more than one agent
6 represents an owner of the publicly accessible collection bin, [~~includ-~~
7 ~~ing a for-profit entity,~~] on behalf of, or in conjunction with a not-
8 for-profit organization, all of the agents' names, legal addresses,
9 telephone numbers and any permits or licenses required by local law of
10 such owners shall be included in the disclosure label; and

11 (b) a statement about the purpose or purposes for the property
12 collected in the bin using letters no less than two inches in height as
13 follows:

43 (d) collection bins owned by a not-for-profit organization shall be
44 exempt from the provisions of this subdivision.
