AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to requiring the department of motor vehicles to transmit voter registrations to the board of elections on a daily basis

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 6 of section 5-212 of the election law, as 2 amended by chapter 200 of the laws of 1996, is amended to read as 3 follows:

6. The department of motor vehicles shall transmit <u>daily</u> that portion of the form which constitutes the completed application for registration or change of address form to the appropriate board of elections [not later than ten days after receipt except that all such completed applications and forms received by the department between the thirtieth and twenty-fifth day before an election shall be transmitted in such manner and at such time as to assure their receipt by such board of elections not later than the twentieth day before such election]. All transmittals shall include original signatures.

13 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
