AN ACT to exempt lemonade stands operated by persons under sixteen years of age from department of health permitting requirements

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of NYCRR sections 14-2.1 and 14-2.2, or any other law, rule or regulation to the contrary, a lemonade stand operated by a person under the age of 16 years shall not be considered to be a temporary food establishment for the purposes of title 10 NYCRR chapter 14.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately. Effective immediately the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective date are authorized to be made on or before such date.
