AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to unclaimed life insurance benefits

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. The opening paragraph of paragraph 4 of subsection (h) of section 3240 of the insurance law, as amended by chapter 10 of the laws of 2013, is amended to read as follows:
- Within [thirty] sixty days of receiving the request referenced in paragraph two of this subsection[, or within forty-five days of receiving the request where the insurer contracts with another entity to maintain the insurer's records,] the insurer shall:
 - § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
