AN ACT to amend the general municipal law, in relation to permitting Essex county to establish a special district for emergency medical services and general ambulance services

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 122-b of the general municipal law is amended by adding a new subdivision 6 to read as follows:

6. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, Essex county may establish a special district for the financing and operation of emergency medical services, general ambulance services or a combination of such services as set forth by this section, whereby such county acting individually, or jointly with any city, town and/or village located within such county, through its governing body or bodies, following applicable procedures as are required for the establishment of special improvement districts in article twelve or twelve-A of the town law, with such special district being authorized by this section to be established in all or any part of Essex county and any such participating town or towns, city or cities and/or village or villages.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
