AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to advertising and labeling of locally produced food

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The agriculture and markets law is amended by adding a new 2 section 211 to read as follows:
- § 211. Advertising and labeling of locally produced foods. 1. For purposes of this section "food product" shall have the same meaning as defined in section one hundred ninety-eight of this article.
- 2. No person, corporation, partnership or limited liability company
 shall knowingly sell or offer for sale any food product advertised or
 labeled as "local", "locally grown", or any substantially similar term,
 unless such food product originated in New York or one hundred miles
 from the location where such food product is for sale.
- 3. A violation of the provisions of this section shall be punishable by a civil penalty not to exceed five hundred dollars for a first violation and one thousand dollars for each subsequent violation.
- 14 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
