AN ACT authorizing and directing the commissioner of education to conduct a study on the number of children who are caregivers and how being a caregiver impacts their education

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The commissioner of education is hereby authorized and 2 directed to conduct a study on the number of children who are caregivers and how being a caregiver impacts the child's education. "Caregiver children" shall be defined as students with sick, disabled, or elderly 5 relatives that such students care for outside of school. The commission-6 er of education shall give recommendations based on the study's find-7 ings. Such study shall include, but not be limited to:

- (a) the number of caregiver children within the state;
- 9 (b) the amount of time caregiver children spend caring for relatives;
 - (c) how being a caregiver child impacts the child's education;
- (d) the circumstances that lead to a child becoming a caregiver child; 11 12 and
- 13 (e) any recommendations on how to reduce the negative educational
- 14 impacts of being a caregiver child. 15 § 2. On or before January 1, 2020, the commissioner of education shall
- 16 submit a report of his or her findings, conclusions and recommendations to the governor, the temporary president of the senate, the speaker of 17
- the assembly, and the chairs of the senate and assembly committees on 18
- education. Such report shall also include such legislative proposals as 19
- such commissioner deems necessary to implement his or her recommenda-20
- 21 tions.
