AN ACT to amend chapter 613 of the laws of 1996, amending the general municipal law relating to buildings that are part of urban development action area projects and are rehabilitated with municipal loans, in relation to the effectiveness thereof

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of chapter 613 of the laws of 1996, amending the
2 general municipal law relating to buildings that are part of urban
3 development action area projects and are rehabilitated with municipal
4 loans, as amended by chapter 65 of the laws of 2014, is amended to read
5 as follows:

6 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall remain in full
7 force and effect until and including June 30, [~~2018~~] 2021 with respect
8 to multiple dwellings rehabilitated with the aid of a loan from a municipality, pursuant to subdivision 1 of section 696-a of the general
9 municipal law as designated by section one of this act, that has closed
10 on or prior to such date, after which date it shall expire and be deemed
11 repealed except that multiple dwellings that are subject to the emergency housing rent control law, the local emergency housing rent control
12 act, the emergency tenant protection act of nineteen seventy-four and/or
13 any local law enacted pursuant thereto pursuant to subdivision 2 of
14 section 696-a of the general municipal law as added by section one of
15 this act, shall continue to be subject thereto as provided in or pursuant to such laws and/or acts.

16 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that
17 if this act shall have become a law after June 30, 2018 it shall be
18 deemed to have been in full force and effect on and after June 30, 2018.
