AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to adding the Nanticoke Creek to the definition of inland waterways

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subdivision 4 of section 911 of the executive law, as separately amended by chapters 43, 110, 142, 161 and 255 of the laws of 2017, is amended to read as follows:

the laws of 2017, is amended to read as follows: (c) the state's major creeks comprised of the 18 Mile Creek located in 5 Erie county, Bash Bish and Kinderhook Creek located in Columbia county, 6 Kinderhook Creek located in Rensselaer county, Basher Kill, Bushkill, 7 Cattaraugus, Cayadutta, Cincinnati, East Kill, Esopus (including upper and lower branches), Fish (including east and west branches), Gooseberry, Kennyetto, Little Sandy, Onondaga, Peekskill Hollow, Roeliff Jansen 9 10 Kill, Rondout, Sandy, Schoharie, Shawangunk Kill, South Sandy, Oatka, 11 Tonawanda, West Kill, Scajaquada, Wappinger, Webatuck, Wassaic, Black 12 Creek located in Monroe county, Black Creek located in Genesee and Wyom-13 ing counties, Ellicott Creek located in Erie county [and], Wynantskill, 14 Claverack, Taghkanic [and], Agawamuck [and], Wyomanock, and Nanticoke; § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
