Introduced by M. of A. DINOWITZ -- read once and referred to the Committee on Health

AN ACT to amend the civil service law, the labor law, the public health law, the education law, the tax law, the vehicle and traffic law, the judiciary law and the executive law, in relation to requiring certain state forms and applications to include space for registering in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue donations; and to repeal certain provisions of the public health law relating thereto

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The civil service law is amended by adding a new section 2 50-d to read as follows:

§ 50-d. Organ, eye and tissue donation. The civil service department and municipal commissions shall provide on each application provided pursuant to section fifty of this title space for the applicant to register in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue 7 donations established pursuant to section forty-three hundred ten of the public health law with the following stated on the application in clear and conspicuous type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". Neither the 10 civil service department nor municipal commissions shall maintain 11 12 records of any person who checks "skip this question". Failure to check 13 "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to imply a 14 wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under sixteen years of 15 age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. Provided, that where 16 an applicant has previously consented to make an anatomical gift or 17 registered in the "donate life registry", failing to check a box shall 18 19 not impair such consent or registration.

- § 2. The labor law is amended by adding a new section 596-a to read as follows:
- § 596-a. Organ, eye and tissue donation. The commissioner shall provide on each claim for benefits made pursuant to section five hundred ninety-six of this title space for the claimant to register in the

"donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue donations established pursuant to section forty-three hundred ten of the public health law 3 with the following stated on the application in clear and conspicuous 4 "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check 5 box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". The commissioner shall not maintain records of any person who checks "skip this question". Failure to 6 check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to 7 8 imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under sixteen 9 years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an 10 anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. Provided, 11 that where a claimant has previously consented to make an anatomical gift or registered in the "donate life registry", failing to check a box 12 13 shall not impair such consent or registration.

- § 3. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 5 of section 4310 of the public health law, as separately amended by chapters 40 and 248 of the laws of 2016, is amended to read as follows:
- (a) Such organ, eye and tissue registration of consent to make an anatomical gift can be made through: (i) indication made on the application or renewal form of a driver's license, (ii) indication made on a 20 non-driver identification card application or renewal form, (iii) indication made on a voter registration form pursuant to subdivision five of section 5-210 of the election law, (iv) indication made on the applica-22 tion for health care coverage offered through the state health benefit exchange, (v) enrollment through the donate life registry website, (vi) 24 paper enrollment submitted to the donate life registry, [ex] (vii) indication made on an application for a civil service examination pursuant to section fifty of the civil service law, (viii) indication made on a claim for unemployment benefits made pursuant to section five hundred ninety-six of the labor law, (ix) indication made on an application for a certificate, license or registration issued pursuant to article sixty-one of the education law, (x) indication made on an application to practice a profession pursuant to title eight of the education law, (xi) indication made on a personal income tax return, (xii) indication made on an application for registration or renewal thereof of a motor vehicle, (xiii) indication made on an application for admission to practice or on a biennial registration form pursuant to section four hundred sixty-four or four hundred sixty-eight-a of the judiciary law, (xiv) indication made on an application to conduct a profession or occupation which is licensed or registered by the department of state, or (xv) through any other method identified by the commissioner. The department shall establish a means by which to register the consent given by individuals who are sixteen or seventeen years of age in the donate life registry, and shall make registration available by any of the methods provided in subparagraphs (i), (ii), (iii), (iv), (v) [and], (vi), 44 (vii), (viii), (ix), (x), (xi), (xii), (xiii), (xiv) and (xv) of paragraph.
- 47 § 4. Paragraphs (b) and (c) of subdivision 5 of section 4310 of the public health law are REPEALED and a new paragraph (b) is added to read 48 49 as follows:
 - (b) Enrollment or amendment or revocation through the donate life registry website through any of the means listed in this subdivision may be signed by electronic signature, in accordance with the provisions of article three of the state technology law, supported by the use of suitable mechanisms including unique identifiers to provide confidence in the identity of the person providing the electronic signature. The registration shall take effect upon the provision of written or elec-

- § 5. Paragraphs (d), (e) and (f) of subdivision 5 of section 4310 of the public health law are relettered paragraphs (c), (d) and (e).
- 5 § 6. Subdivision 1 of section 206 of the public health law is amended 6 by adding eight new paragraphs (w), (x), (y), (z), (aa), (bb), (cc) and 7 (dd) to read as follows:

(w) require, in consultation and cooperation with the civil service 8 9 department and municipal commissions, that every individual applying for 10 a civil service examination be provided space so that such applicant may register in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue 11 donations under section forty-three hundred ten of this chapter with the 12 following stated in clear conspicuous type: "Would you like to be added 13 14 to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". Neither the civil service department nor municipal commissions 15 16 shall maintain records of any person who checks "skip this question". Except where the application is made in person or electronically, fail-17 ure to check a box shall not impair the validity of an application, and 18 19 failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be 20 construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant 21 under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. 22 Where an applicant has previously consented to make an anatomical gift 23 or registered in the donate life registry, checking "skip this question" 24 or failing to check a box shall not impair that consent or registration. 25 26 (x) require, in consultation and cooperation with the commissioner of 27 the department of labor, that every individual filing a claim for unemployment benefits be provided space so that such applicant may register 28 29 in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue donations under 30 section forty-three hundred ten of this chapter with the following stat-31 ed in clear conspicuous type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate 32 Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". The commis-33 sioner shall not maintain records of any person who checks "skip this question". Except where the claim for benefits is made in person or 34 35 electronically, failure to check a box shall not impair the validity of an application, and failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this ques-36 tion" shall not be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case 37 of a claimant under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not 38 constitute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration in the 39 donate life registry. Where a claimant has previously consented to make 40 41 an anatomical gift or registered in the donate life registry, checking 42 "skip this question" or failing to check a box shall not impair that 43 consent or registration.

(y) require, in consultation and cooperation with the commissioner of education, that every individual applying for a certificate, license or registration issued pursuant to article sixty-one of the education law, be provided space so that such applicant may register in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue donations under section forty-three hundred ten of this chapter with the following stated in clear conspicuous type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". The commissioner shall not maintain records of any person who checks "skip this question". Except where the application is made in person or electronically, failure to check a box shall not impair the validity of an application, and failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant

under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. Where an applicant has previously consented to make an anatomical gift or registered in the donate life registry, checking "skip this question" or failing to check a box shall not impair that consent or registration. (z) require, in consultation and cooperation with the commissioner of education, that every individual applying to practice a profession pursuant to title eight of the education law, be provided space so that such applicant may register in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue donations under section forty-three hundred ten of this chapter with the following stated in clear conspicuous type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". The commissioner shall not maintain records of any person who checks "skip this question". Except where the application is made in person or electronically, failure to check a box shall not impair the validity of an application, and failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. Where an applicant has previously consented to make an anatomical gift or registered in the donate life registry, checking "skip this question" or failing to check a box shall not impair that consent or registration.

(aa) require, in consultation and cooperation with the department of taxation and finance, that every individual filing a personal income tax return be provided space so that such applicant may register in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue donations under section forty-three hundred ten of this chapter with the following stated in clear conspicuous type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". The commissioner shall not maintain records of any person who checks "skip this question". Except where the application is made in person or electronically, failure to check a box shall not impair the validity of an application, and failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. Where an applicant has previously consented to make an anatomical gift or registered in the donate life registry, checking "skip this question" or failing to check a box shall not impair that consent or registration. (bb) require, in consultation and cooperation with the commissioner of motor vehicles, that every individual applying for a registration or renewal thereof of a motor vehicle be provided space so that such applicant may register in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue donations under section forty-three hundred ten of this chapter with the following stated in clear conspicuous type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". The commissioner shall not maintain records of any person who checks "skip this question". Except where the application is made in person or electronically, failure to check a box shall not impair the validity of an application, and failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. Where an applicant has previously consented to make an anatomical gift or registered in the donate life registry,

1 checking "skip this question" or failing to check a box shall not impair 2 that consent or registration.

3 (cc) require, in consultation and cooperation with the state board of 4 law examiners, that every individual applying for admission to practice 5 or on a biennial registration form pursuant to section four hundred 6 sixty-four or four hundred sixty-eight-a of the judiciary law, be 7 provided space so that such applicant may register in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue donations under section forty-three 8 9 hundred ten of this chapter with the following stated in clear conspicu-10 ous type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". The commissioner shall not main-11 tain records of any person who checks "skip this question". Except where 12 13 the application is made in person or electronically, failure to check a 14 box shall not impair the validity of an application, and failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to 15 16 imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under sixteen 17 years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. Where an 18 19 applicant has previously consented to make an anatomical gift or regis-20 tered in the donate life registry, checking "skip this question" or 21 failing to check a box shall not impair that consent or registration.

(dd) require, in consultation and cooperation with the secretary of state, that every individual applying to conduct a profession or occupation which is licensed or registered by the department of state be provided space so that such applicant may register in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue donations under section forty-three hundred ten of this chapter with the following stated in clear conspicuous type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". The commissioner shall not maintain records of any person who checks "skip this question". Except where the application is made in person or electronically, failure to check a box shall not impair the validity of an application, and failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. Where an applicant has previously consented to make an anatomical gift or registered in the donate life registry, checking "skip this question" or failing to check a box shall not impair that consent or registration.

§ 7. Section 3006 of the education law is amended by adding a new subdivision 4 to read as follows:

4. Organ, eye and tissue donation. The commissioner shall provide on each application for a certificate, license or registration issued pursuant to this article, and each renewal thereof, space for the applicant to register in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue donations established pursuant to section forty-three hundred ten of the public health law with the following stated on the application in clear and conspicuous type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". The regents shall not maintain records of any person who checks "skip this question". Failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. Provided, that where an applicant has previously consented to make an

anatomical gift or registered in the "donate life registry", failing to check a box shall not impair such consent or registration.

- 3 § 8. Section 6501 of the education law is amended by adding a new 4 subdivision 3 to read as follows:
- 5 3. The regents shall provide, on each application to practice a 6 profession pursuant to this title and each application for renewal of a 7 license, registration or certification to practice such a profession, 8 space for the applicant to register in the "donate life registry" of 9 organ, eye and tissue donations established pursuant to section forty-10 three hundred ten of the public health law with the following stated on the application in clear and conspicuous type: "Would you like to be 11 added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this 12 13 question'". The regents shall not maintain records of any person who 14 checks "skip this question". Failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In 15 16 the case of an applicant under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" 17 shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. Provided, that where an applicant has 18 previously consented to make an anatomical gift or registered in the 19 20 "donate life registry", failing to check a box shall not impair such 21 consent or registration.
- 9. Section 651 of the tax law is amended by adding a new subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
 - (a-1) Organ, eye and tissue donation. The commissioner shall provide on each return space for the taxpayer or taxpayers to register in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue donations established pursuant to section forty-three hundred ten of the public health law with the following stated on the application in clear and conspicuous type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". The commissioner shall not maintain records of any person who checks "skip this question". Failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. Provided, that where a taxpayer has previously consented to make an anatomical gift or registered in the "donate life registry", failing to check a box shall not impair such consent or registration.
 - § 10. Paragraph b of subdivision 1 of section 401 of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new closing paragraph to read as follows:

42 The commissioner shall provide on each application for registration 43 and renewal thereof space for the motor vehicle owner to register in the 44 "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue donations established 45 pursuant to section forty-three hundred ten of the public health law 46 with the following stated on the application in clear and conspicuous 47 type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". The commissioner shall not maintain 48 records of any person who checks "skip this question". Failure to check 49 "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to imply a 50 51 wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical 52 53 gift or registration in the donate life registry. Provided, that where a 54 motor vehicle owner has previously consented to make an anatomical gift or registered in the "donate life registry", failing to check a box 55 56 shall not impair such consent or registration.

§ 11. Section 464 of the judiciary law is amended by adding a new closing paragraph to read as follows:

3 The chief administrator of the courts shall provide on each applica-4 tion for admission to practice, space for the applicant to register in 5 the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue donations estab-6 lished pursuant to section forty-three hundred ten of the public health 7 law with the following stated on the application in clear and conspicu-8 ous type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". The chief administrator of the 9 10 courts shall not maintain records of any person who checks "skip this question". Failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this question" 11 shall not be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an 12 13 applicant under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not consti-14 tute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. Provided, that where an applicant has previously 15 16 consented to make an anatomical gift or registered in the "donate life 17 registry", failing to check a box shall not impair such consent or 18 registration.

§ 12. Section 468-a of the judiciary law is amended by adding a new subdivision 4-a to read as follows:

4-a. The chief administrator shall provide on each biennial registration form space for the attorney to register in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue donations established pursuant to section forty-three hundred ten of the public health law with the following stated on the application in clear and conspicuous type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". The chief administrator shall not maintain records of any person who checks "skip this question". Failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. Provided, that where an attorney has previously consented to make an anatomical gift or registered in the "donate life registry", failing to check a box shall not impair such consent or registration.

§ 13. The executive law is amended by adding a new section 91-a to read as follows:

§ 91-a. Organ, eye and tissue donation. The secretary shall provide on each application to conduct a profession or occupation which is licensed or registered by the department, and each renewal thereof, space for the applicant to register in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue donations established pursuant to section fortythree hundred ten of the public health law with the following stated on the application in clear and conspicuous type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". The secretary shall not maintain records of any person who checks "skip this question". Failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. Provided, that where an applicant has previously consented to make an anatomical gift or registered in the "donate life registry", failing to check a box shall not impair such consent or registration.

§ 14. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law; provided, however,
