AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to transportation of patients

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 33.17 of the mental hygiene law, as renumbered by 2 chapter 978 of the laws of 1977, is amended to read as follows:

§ 33.17 Transportation of [female patients] individuals.

4 [Any female patient] Within staffing limitations and upon request, an individual who is being transported to or from a facility [shall] may be accompanied by [another female, unless accompanied by her father, brother, husband, or son] same gender staff.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
