AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to methods used to capture or dispose of nuisance wildlife

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 5 of section 11-0524 of the environmental conservation law, as added by chapter 265 of the laws of 2002, is amended to read as follows:
5. Any person licensed pursuant to this section shall submit annually a report to the department which specifies each client's name and address, the date work was performed, the species controlled, the abatement method used, the disposition of the animal, and if a lethal method was used to capture or dispose of such animal, the lethal method used and the reason why a non-lethal method was not used, and any other information as required by the department. The department shall annually update a list of nuisance wildlife control operators and enforcement actions taken by the department against any nuisance wildlife control operator for violations of the law and applicable regulations and make it available to the public in both printed and electronic formats.
§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
