AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system in the village of Philadelphia, county of Jefferson as the "New York State Trooper Joel R. Davis Memorial Bridge"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-h to 2 read as follows:

- § 344-h. Portion of the state highway system to be designated as the 4 "New York State Trooper Joel R. Davis Memorial Bridge". The bridge on 5 United States route eleven crossing the Indian River in the village of 6 Philadelphia, county of Jefferson, shall be designated and known as the "New York State Trooper Joel R. Davis Memorial Bridge".
- 8 § 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the instal-9 lation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system 10 as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid 11 confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the desig-12 nation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of 13 ceremonial nature and the official name of such bridge shall not be 14 changed as a result of this act.
  - § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
