AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to prohibiting the use of certain grades of fuel oil

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The environmental conservation law is amended by adding a new section 19-0329 to read as follows:

§ 19-0329. Certain fuel oil; prohibited.

1. On and after July first, two thousand twenty, no fuel oil, grade number six, as classified by American Society for Testing Materials Standard D396-15c, shall be used in any building or facility owned or operated by the state, or any agency thereof.

2. On and after July first, two thousand twenty-two, no fuel oil, grade number four, as classified by American Society for Testing Materials Standard D396-15c, shall be used in any building or facility owned or operated by the state, or any agency thereof.

3. Nothing in this section shall prevent a municipality from adopting a law, code, ordinance or regulation which is more stringent than the requirements of this section.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
