AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to prohibiting school districts from asking invasive questions when a voter requests an absentee ballot for school related elections and votes

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph b of subdivision 2 of section 2018-a of the education law, as amended by chapter 136 of the laws of 1991 , is amended to read as follows:
b. [(1) Where oueh duties, oeeupation, business, or otudies are of oueh a nature as ordinarily to require oueh aboenee, a brief desexiption of sueh duties, oceupation, business, or studies shall be set forth in such application. (2) Where sueh duties, oecupation, business, or studies are not of sueh a nature as oxdinaxily to require sueh absenee, suoh applieation shall oontain a statement of the special oireumstanees on aeeount of which sueh absenee ic required] No application for an absentee ballot shall require the applicant to divulge the destination, duration, or reason for their vacation, occupation or business related travel, or study related absence from the district.
§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
