The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1	Section 1. Section 21 of the labor law is amended by adding a new

3	16. Shall require employers to inform their workers that non-disclo-
4	sure or non-disparagement provisions in their employment contracts
5	cannot prevent them from speaking with law enforcement, the equal
б	employment opportunity commission, the state division of human rights,
7	<u>or a local commission on human rights.</u>
8	§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
