AN ACT to amend the general obligations law, in relation to independent consideration required for certain provisions in settlement agreements

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The general obligations law is amended by adding a new 2 section 5-1117 to read as follows:

§ 5-1117. Independent consideration required for settlement agreements. Independent consideration shall be required for each confidentiality provision included in a settlement agreement. For the purposes
of this section, "independent consideration" shall mean something of
value, either a promise, an act or an object that is offered in exchange
for each confidentiality provision.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
