AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to reporting a nonemergency incident to an organization having the function of dealing with emergencies

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 240.49 to 2 read as follows:

3 <u>§ 240.49 Reporting a nonemergency incident.</u>

A person is guilty of reporting a nonemergency incident when, knowing the information reported, conveyed or circulated to be a nonemergency situation, he or she initiates or circulates a report or warning to an official or quasi-official agency or organization having the function of dealing with emergencies involving danger to life or property of an alleged occurrence or impending occurrence of a nonemergency situation in which it is unlikely that a threat to public safety will result. Reporting a nonemergency incident is a class B misdemeanor. § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
