- AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to establishing "Jeremiah's Law" relating to establishing the offense of filing a false report concerning a minor

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Short title. This act shall be known and may be cited as 1 "Jeremiah's Law". 2 § 2. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 240.49 to read 3 4 as follows: 5 <u>§ 240.49 Filing a false report concerning a minor.</u> б A person is guilty of filing a false report concerning a minor when he 7 or she falsely reports an incident in the third degree as described in section 240.50 of this article and the individual who is the accused 8 subject of the report is a child under the age of thirteen years. 9 10 Filing a false report concerning a minor is a class E felony. 11 § 3. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-

12 ing the date upon which it shall have become a law.
