AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to endangering the welfare of a vulnerable elderly person, or an incompetent or physically disabled person

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 260.31 of the penal law, as 2 amended by chapter 14 of the laws of 2010, is amended to read as 3 follows:
- 1. "Caregiver" means a person who (i) assumes responsibility for the care of a vulnerable elderly person, or an incompetent or physically disabled person pursuant to a court order[; or], or otherwise by operation of law; (ii) receives monetary or other valuable consideration for providing such care; or (iii) voluntarily assumes responsibility for providing care for a vulnerable elderly person, or an incompetent or physically disabled person.
- 11 § 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall 12 have become a law.
