AN ACT to amend the correction law, in relation to the confinement of inmates under the age of eighteen

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

## Section 1. The opening paragraph of subdivision 6 of section 137 of the correction law, as amended by chapter 1 of the laws of 2008, is amended to read as follows:

4 Except as provided in paragraphs (d) and (e) of this subdivision, the 5 superintendent of a correctional facility may keep any inmate, other 6 than inmates under the age of eighteen years who shall not be placed in 7 segregated confinement for any reason, confined in a cell or room, apart 8 from the accommodations provided for inmates who are participating in 9 programs of the facility, for such period as may be necessary for main-10 tenance of order or discipline, but in any such case the following 11 conditions shall be observed:

12 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
