AN ACT to amend the real property tax law, in relation to increasing the base figure for the enhanced school tax relief exception

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subparagraph (vi) of paragraph (b) of subdivision 2 of 2 section 425 of the real property tax law, as added by section 1 of part 3 D-1 of chapter 57 of the laws of 2007, clause (A) as further amended by 4 subdivision (b) of section 1 of part W of chapter 56 of the laws of 5 2010, is amended and two new subparagraphs (vii) and (viii) are added to 6 read as follows:

7 (vi) For the two thousand nine--two thousand ten school year [and 8 thereafter] through the two thousand seventeen--two thousand eighteen 9 school year:

(A) The base figure for the enhanced STAR exemption shall equal the 10 11 prior year's base figure multiplied by the percentage increase in the 12 consumer price index for urban wage earners and clerical workers (CPI-W) 13 published by the United States department of labor, bureau of labor 14 statistics, for the third quarter of the calendar year preceding the applicable school year, as compared to the third quarter of the prior 15 calendar year. If a base figure as so determined is not exactly equal to 16 17 a multiple of one hundred dollars, it shall be rounded to the nearest multiple of one hundred dollars. It shall be the responsibility of the 18 19 commissioner to annually determine such base figures.

20 (B) The base figure for the basic STAR exemption shall be thirty thou-21 sand dollars.

22 <u>(vii) For the two thousand eighteen--two thousand nineteen school</u> 23 <u>year, the base figure shall be seventy-five thousand eight hundred</u>
