AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to the sale of alcoholic beverages at customer-operated point-of-sale stations

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 2 399-eee to read as follows:
- § 399-eee. Prohibited sale of alcoholic beverages at customer-operated point-of-sale stations. 1. Sale of alcoholic beverages by retail establishments licensed pursuant to the alcoholic beverage control law is prohibited at customer-operated point-of-sale stations.
- 7 <u>2. For purposes of this section, "customer-operated point-of-sale</u> 8 <u>station" means a self-scanning checkout where customers pay for and bag</u> 9 <u>their own merchandise without interacting with a human cashier.</u>
- 10 3. Violation of this section shall be subject to a fine of no less
  11 than five hundred dollars and no more than one thousand dollars.
- 12 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
