AN ACT to amend the village law, in relation to including a high school member on village boards of trustees

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Paragraph b of subdivision 1 of section 3-301 of the village law is amended to read as follows:
- b. four trustees, except that the board of trustees of a village may change the number of trustees as authorized by section 3-304 of this article, and except that the board of trustees of a village may appoint one student representative to such board as authorized by section 3-305 of this article;
- 8 \S 2. The village law is amended by adding a new section 3-305 to read 9 as follows:
- 9 as follows:
 10 § 3-305 Student representative. The board of trustees by resolution
 11 or local law may appoint one student representative to such board. Such
- 12 student representative shall be a senior in a high school of a school
- 13 district in which all or part of such school district is contained with-
- 14 in such village. The term of such student representative shall be for
- 15 one year and shall begin on the July first preceding the senior year of
- 16 such student representative and end the following June thirtieth. A
- 17 vacancy of such representative may be filled by the board for the
- 18 remainder of such term. Such student representative shall be entitled
- 19 to sit with board members at all public meetings of the board and
- 20 participate in all board hearings and meetings, provided that such
- 21 student representative shall not be allowed to vote, shall not be
- 22 allowed to attend executive session, and shall not be entitled to
- 23 receive compensation of any form.
