AN ACT to amend the correction law, in relation to confidential hearing records

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 138 of the correction law is amended by adding a
2 new subdivision 7 to read as follows:

3 7. An attorney representing an inmate in any appeal of a disciplinary
4 proceeding or in any lawsuit related to such a proceeding shall be
5 provided with a copy of the entire hearing record but shall not redis-
6 close such records to any person not otherwise authorized by law to
7 obtain them. The name, identification number, housing location or work
8 assignment of any confidential informant may be redacted from such hear-
9 ing record.

10 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
