AN ACT to exempt military re-enactors from the provisions of chapter 1 of the laws of 2013

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any law, rule or regulation to the contrary, military re-enactors who are not residents of the state of New York and who bring weapons into the state of New York for the sole purpose of using such weapons in the course of staging military battle re-enactments shall be exempt from the provisions of chapter 1 of the laws of 2013.

7 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
