AN ACT to amend the town law, in relation to requiring an electronic version of a town clerk's sign-board on a town website

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 6 of section 30 of the town law is amended to 2 read as follows:

6. At the expense of the town he <u>or she</u> shall procure and affix on or near the main entrance to his <u>or her</u> office a sign-board with the name of the town followed by the words "town clerk's office" in plain characters thereon with sufficient space immediately below for posting thereon the legal notices of the town. Such sign-board <u>and, in any town that</u> <u>maintains a website, an electronic version of such sign-board</u> shall be one of the public places upon which any legal notice may be posted. <u>Towns which maintain a website shall maintain an electronic version of</u> <u>such sign-board and shall post a link to the electronic version of the</u> <u>sign-board on its homepage.</u>

13 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 14 have become a law.
