AN ACT to amend the not-for-profit corporation law, in relation to a member's request to inspect the books and records of the corporation

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section. 1. Subdivision (e) of section 621 of the not-for-profit
2 corporation law, as amended by chapter 549 of the laws of 2013, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 (e) Upon the written request of any person who shall have been a
5 member of record for at least six months immediately preceding his
6 request, or of any person holding, or thereunto authorized in writing by
7 the holders of, at least five percent of any class of the outstanding
8 capital certificates, the corporation shall provide to such member an
9 annual balance sheet and profit and loss statement or a financial state-
10 ment performing a similar function for the preceding fiscal year,
11 including, but not limited to, invoices, ledgers, bank accounts, recon-
12 ciliations, and contracts and, if any interim balance sheet or profit
13 and loss or similar financial statement has been distributed to its
14 members or otherwise made available to the public, the most recent such
15 interim balance sheet or profit and loss or similar financial statement
16 including, but not limited to, invoices, ledgers, bank accounts, recon-
17 ciliations, and contracts. The corporation shall be allowed a reasonable
18 time to prepare such annual balance sheet and profit and loss or similar
19 financial statement.

20 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
