AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to requiring health insurance policies to provide coverage for medically necessary care for the treatment of autism spectrum disorder

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1	Section 1. Paragraph 25 of subsection (i) of section 3216 of the
2	insurance law is amended by adding a new subparagraph (H) to read as
3	follows:
4	(H) Every policy which provides coverage for hospital, surgical, or
5	medical care coverage shall provide any and all diagnostic screening,
6	tests, and assessments and treatment including medical care, consulta-
7	tion, habilitation, rehabilitation, speech, behavioral, occupational and
8	physical therapies, pediatric, neurological, gastro-enterologic, and any
9	other medically necessary care that is provided by a licensed provider
10	required for the treatment of autism spectrum disorder, including
11	Asperger's disorder and pervasive developmental disorders as determined
12	by the treating physician.
13	§ 2. Paragraph 17 of subsection (1) of section 3221 of the insurance
14	law is amended by adding a new subparagraph (H) to read as follows:
15	(H) Every policy which provides coverage for hospital, surgical, or
16	medical care coverage shall provide any and all diagnostic screening,
17	tests, and assessments and treatment including medical care, consulta-
18	tion, habilitation, rehabilitation, speech, behavioral, occupational and
19	physical therapies, pediatric, neurological, gastro-enterologic, and any
20	other medically necessary care that is provided by a licensed provider
21	required for the treatment of autism spectrum disorder, including
22	Asperger's disorder and pervasive developmental disorders as determined
23	by the treating physician.
