AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to creating a presumption of intent to sell

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 220.26 to 2 read as follows:
- 3 § 220.26 Presumption of intent to sell.
  - For the purposes of a prosecution of a charge under subdivision one of
- 5 section 220.16 of this article, the possession of thirty or more indi-
- 6 vidual packages containing the controlled substance defined under para-
- 7 graph eleven of subdivision (c) of schedule I of section thirty-three
- 8 <u>hundred six of the public health law and/or the possession of such</u>
  9 <u>controlled substance in an amount having an aggregate value of three</u>
- Controlled Substance in an amount having an aggregate value of three
- 10 <u>hundred dollars or more, is presumptive evidence that such person</u>
- 11 possessed such controlled substance with intent to sell it.
- 12 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall
- 13 have become a law.
