Introduced by M. of A. ORTIZ -- read once and referred to the Committee on Election Law

AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to the determination of a winner of a primary election; and to repeal section 6-162 of the election law, subdivision 5 of section 3-705 and subdivision 6 of section 3-709 of the administrative code of the city of New York relating to run-off primary elections in the city of New York

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 6-160 of the election law is amended by adding a
2 new subdivision 3 to read as follows:
3 3. The individual who receives the highest percentage of the total
4 votes cast at the primary shall be deemed the winner of the primary.
5 § 2. Section 6-162 of the election law is REPEALED.
6 § 3. Subdivision 5 of section 3-705 of the administrative code of the
7 city of New York is REPEALED.
8 § 4. Subdivision 6 of section 3-709 of the administrative code of the
9 city of New York is REPEALED.
10 § 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
