AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system in the town of Hancock, county of Delaware as the "Lt. Cameron N. Hall Memorial Bridge"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 342-ddd 2 to read as follows:

§ 342-ddd. Portion of the state highway system to be designated as the 4 "Lt. Cameron N. Hall Memorial Bridge". The bridge on state route ninety-seven, designated New York state bridge number 1035450, in the town of Hancock, county of Delaware, shall be designated and known as the "Lt. Cameron N. Hall Memorial Bridge".

- 8 § 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system 10 as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the desig-12 nation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of 13 ceremonial nature and the official name of such bridge shall not be 14 changed as a result of this act.
- 15 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
