AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to granting peace officer status to certain titles employed by the Nassau county police department

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 2.10 of the criminal procedure law is amended by 1 2 adding a new subdivision 85 to read as follows: 3 85. Ambulance medical technicians, ambulance medical technician supervisors, ambulance medical technician coordinators, bureau directors; 4 5 police ambulance services, and assistant bureau directors; police ambuб lance services employed by the Nassau county police department; 7 provided, however, that nothing in this subdivision shall be deemed to 8 authorize such persons to carry, possess, repair, or dispose of a firearm unless the appropriate license therefor has been issued pursuant 9 10 to section 400.00 of the penal law.

11 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
