AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in  
relation to requiring pedestrian-control signals to indicate that all  
pedestrians at an intersection shall cross the street at the same time

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assem-  
bly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The administrative code of the city of New York is amended  
2 by adding a new section 19-196 to read as follows:

3 § 19-196 Pedestrian-control signals; timing. Any intersection with a  
4 pedestrian-control signal shall have such signal programmed to indicate  
5 that all pedestrians at the intersection shall cross the street at the  
6 same time. No traffic-control signal shall indicate a green light for  
7 traffic while a pedestrian-control signal at such intersection displays  
8 a signal indicating walk or a steady walking person.

9 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
