AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to coverage for the screening, diagnosis and treatment of autism spectrum disorder

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subclause 5 of clause (ix) of subparagraph (C) of paragraph 2 25 of subsection (i) of section 3216 of the insurance law, as amended by 3 chapter 596 of the laws of 2011, is amended to read as follows:

4 (5) therapeutic care, including therapeutic care which is deemed habi5 litative or nonrestorative[, in the event that the policy provides

7 § 2. Subclause 5 of clause (ix) of subparagraph (C) of paragraph 17 8 of subsection (1) of section 3221 of the insurance law, as amended by 9 chapter 596 of the laws of 2011, is amended to read as follows:

10 (5) therapeutic care, including therapeutic care which is deemed habi-11 litative or nonrestorative[<del>, in the event that the policy provides</del> 12 <del>coverage for therapeutic care</del>]; and

13 § 3. Clause (v) of subparagraph (I) of paragraph 3 of subsection (ee) 14 of section 4303 of the insurance law, as amended by chapter 596 of the 15 laws of 2011, is amended to read as follows:

16 (v) therapeutic care, including therapeutic care which is deemed habi-17 litative or nonrestorative[<del>, in the event that the policy provides</del> 18 <del>coverage for therapeutic care</del>]; and

19 § 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
